Work Day Credit: Each school year we schedule two "Parent Work Days". One is generally before school starts and the other in September or October. Base school parents who work 4 hours at the school will earn \$100 off a student's tuition (two student's maximum).

Scholarships: Edgemont Bible Church does provide a small amount of financial assistance each year for tuition. Applications may be picked up at the school office and must be turned in by August 1st. Determination of scholarships will be decided by the beginning of the school year.

Payment Options: (We use the FACTS Tuition Management Company for families paying their tuition on a monthly basis.)

- Full payment of tuition for the year by August 1st – Paid directly to the school. **Base school** families paying with this method will reduce their tuition by **\$100.00 per child**. **Homeschool** families paying with this method will reduce their tuition by **\$50.00 per family**.
- One half of tuition paid by August 1st. The remainder paid in full by December 31st. Both payments will be made directly to the school. **Base school** families paying with this method will reduce their tuition by **\$50.00 per child**.
- Ten (10) automatic monthly payments through the FACTS Payment Plan. ~~ Option of payments on the **5th or 20th** of the month. Payments on the **5th** will begin August 5th and end May 5th; Payments on the **20th** will begin July 20th and end April 20th.
- Twelve (12) automatic monthly payments through the FACTS Payment Plan. ~~ Option of payments on the **5th or 20th** of the month. Payments on the **5th** will begin June 5th and end May 5th; Payments on the **20th** will begin May 20th and end April 20th.
